SENSORY FRIENDLY MOVIES AVAILABLE AT EAGLES

Eagles Theatre to Host Accessible Movie Showings Regularly

During its renovation, Eagles Theatre in downtown Wabash installed a second theatre in the lower level of the building. The Ferguson Theatre is designed to seat 49 guests, including handicap accessible seating, and serves as an intimate movie viewing space. Sensory friendly films will be shown regularly, featuring new release movies at a lower volume with more room lighting than a typical movie showing.

The Dekko Foundation and the AWS Foundation generously granted funds to ensure regularly-shown sensory friendly films at Eagles Theatre. The Honeywell Foundation strives to provide opportunities for self-expression and creativity through arts-based entertainment, and sensory friendly films provide access to current media to all guests.

Additionally, Sensory Friendly Kits are free to use in both the Eagles Theatre and the Ferguson Theatre during any live event or movie showing. Each kit contains noise-reducing headphones, three small fidget items, a communications deck, identification wristband, a weighted comfort item, sanitizing wipes and an AWS Foundation kit overview card. The Sensory Friendly Kits are available for pick-up before the event at the Box Office, and are to be returned at the end of the event.
